## Getting to the Thames clubhouse:

- **By car** – travel on the southbound carriageway of the A3 and 150 metres before the Robin Hood junction turn left into the Richardson Evans Memorial Fields car park. The car park is here:

- **By public transport:** take the no. 85 bus from Putney Bridge or Putney BR station and get off at the Asda stop (12 mins from Putney BR station). It is then a short walk down the A3 to the Thames clubhouse. Alternatively the 265 from Barnes also stops at Asda on the A3.

The clubhouse is located at the south western end of the pavilion complex, nearest to the bridge over the Beverly Brook. Our door has the familiar THH emblem on it shown below and is located here:
